

## Marks Hall – Supporting Our Work

Marks Hall covers some 2,300 acres and is owned by the Marks Hall Estate. Since the establishment of the Trust in 1971 great progress has been made in restoring this historic Estate, which had become much neglected after the Second World War. It is now a place where visitors can enjoy peace and tranquillity in beautiful surroundings and offers great opportunities to watch wildlife. For the frequent visitor the Gardens and Arboretum offer something different throughout the year from snowdrops to spring blossom, summer flowers and wonderful autumn colour.

As a registered charity the Trust is dependant on its own resources and the valued support of visitors, members and volunteers to achieve its aims including development of the Gardens and Arboretum. - A quarterly news and events leaflet keeping you informed about future activities at Marks Hall.

- Children 16 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- Car parks are provided for visitors use. Parking elsewhere is not permitted.
- Dogs, other than guide dogs, are not allowed in the Gardens and Arboretum and, although welcome elsewhere, must be kept under strict control.
